**Renate Frydman, Ph.D.**, from Montgomery County, has worked as a contributing writer for the Dayton Daily News for 30 years. She has been involved with Holocaust education and remembrance since the 1960's till the present. Renate is curator of and docent for the Holocaust Exhibit, Prejudice & Memory at the Museum of the U.S. Air Force in Dayton which has over a million visitors a year. This book, "Ansel's Story: Determined to Live" is her tribute to the man she was married to for 51 years.

**Book Featured: Ansel's Story: Determined to Survive, c2014.** — This book is a heart-stopping journey told in first person, which describes unusual courage and uncanny luck. It is the true story of a young teenager who lost everyone and everything during the Holocaust. He fought to live on in spite of ghettos, fatal line-ups, enslavement in work camps and years of survival as a partisan in Polish forests.
