



Cornhole Maker Kit

Guide

Cornhole is a popular lawn game where players or teams take turns throwing fabric bean bags at raised, angled boards which have a hole in the far ends. The goal of the game is to score points by either landing a bag on the board or putting a bag through the hole.

Starting Out

To set up a cornhole game, each board should be placed directly opposite the other, on the ground, with 27 feet between the front ends of each board. There are 8 total bags in a Cornhole game, which are separated into two groups, each group with its own color and assigned team/player. A coin flip typically determines which player/team will begin tossing the bean bags first. The loser of the coin flip will toss second and players will then alternate throws between teams until no bags remain for that round. Scores are typically 3 points for a bag which makes it into the opposing hole, 1 point for landing on the face of the board, and no points are awarded if a bag does not make it on the board or touches the ground during gameplay or touches another bag which is touching the ground. Players should not pass the front edge of the board when tossing or it is considered a foul and will generate zero points. Players and teams typically place several rounds until 21 points total are reached.
