Starting Out

You should start by unrolling the keyboard and plugging it into a power source. The included sustain pedal can be attached to the keyboard to mimic the experience of playing on a real piano.

Once the keyboard is powered on, you can use the included books to go through the various notes, learn finger placements, and begin making music!
