



Ladder Toss Maker Kit

Guide

Ladder toss involves tossing bolas—pairs of balls connected by a string—towards a ladder-shaped target in an attempt to loop them around the rungs and earn points. It can be played one-on-one or in teams of two.

Starting Out

This kit includes everything you need to enjoy ladder toss in your own yard. First, follow the assembly instructions on the laminated assembly and game play sheet. Once the ladder toss set is assembled, place them 25 feet apart. Beginners may want to place it a little closer together for less of a challenge. Next, each player takes a turn throwing the bolas at the ladder. You will score points according to which rung the bola wraps around. The first player (or team of players) to 21 points wins the game!

Be mindful of your surroundings and make sure that you are not throwing bolas in a direction that could damage or injure anything.
