Makedo is a set of tools designed to allow kids to think creatively and build using materials around them. There are no real instructions, only tools that allow kids to create and build!

Starting Out

Makedo is designed to allow your child to build with cardboard. It comes with a precision cardboard saw, a safe-saw, mini-tools, a “scru-driver,” and regular and XL size “scrus.” The only thing that you need to supply is the cardboard and your imagination. This kit comes with reusable parts for endless creative play.

CAUTION: The precision cardboard saw can cut skin if enough pressure is applied.
