

Needle Felting Maker Kit

Guide

Needle felting is the process of felting/tangling one piece of wool to another using barbed needles. The needles take the wool fibers from one piece and drag them through the other piece where they tangle and attach the two pieces. There are two types of needle felting: **applique felting** (attaches wool roving to a flat piece of wool fabric or felt), and **sculptural felting** (3D art made from wool roving).

To eliminate risk from contaminated needles, we ask that you keep the needles given in this kit. We will not be able to reuse them at the library.

Project Ideas

In this kit, we've included a book on how to needle felt, wool roving, felting needles, and a mat. If you are a beginner start simply. Once you understand the technique you can move up to more advance needle felting projects. Here are a few links for needle felting.
