

Pressure Washer Maker Kit

Guide

The Westinghouse WPX2300e cold-water, electric pressure washer is a compact and powerful tool that excels in cleaning a variety of surfaces including driveways, decks, vehicles, and more. With multiple nozzle options and a pro-steel spray wand, this 2300 PSI and 1.76 GPM deep cleaning tool will be sure to scrub away all mildew, grease, tar, oil, mud. rust and more.

Starting Out

To begin, it is highly advised that you read the User Manual in order to fully understand the utmost importance of safety when handling and using a pressure washer.



Pressure Washer Maker Kit Starting Out - continued

To begin setting up the pressure washer, turn off the water faucet connection completely. Uncoil and straighten the garden hose to remove any bends or kinks and flush water through the hose to remove any debris, then turn the faucet off again. Insert the garden hose into the water inlet and make sure to tighten it securely onto the pressure washer.

With totally dry hands, completely unwind the power cord and connect it to a grounded 120 volt outlet. **Do not touch the plug with wet hands.**

Make sure to turn the water faucet back to the "ON" position before turning pressure washer power to "ON".



Pressure Washer Maker Kit Starting Out - continued

Hold the trigger handle with both hands and point the lance in a safe direction. Release the safety lock and squeeze the trigger to release water and air out of the hose. Continue squeezing the trigger until there is a steady stream of water, then release and lock the trigger. Use as needed.

When you stop the pressure washer, water pressure may remain in the system. Point the trigger handle in a safe direction and pull the trigger to release the water pressure after you have safely turned off the water supply.

Please turn off the pressure washer after five minutes of inactivity.



Pressure Washer Maker Kit Starting Out - continued If using detergent, ONLY USE detergent designed for pressure washers. The detergent should be the consistency of water.

DO NOT USE thick, gel-like detergents, as they will clog the pressure washer and can cause damage to the machine.

When you are finished, remove excess detergent from the soap tank and fill it with clean water. Spray the water through the soap nozzle to fully flush the system.

Please clean off the pressure washer and remove any detergent or water from container prior to returning the kit back to the library.

Light pressure. Used for general purpose cleaning, especially on delicate surfaces like cars, windows, and painted surfaces



SOAP NOZZLE

Low pressure. Safe for cars, windows and decks.
