Note: Never look directly at the sun with your naked eye or with a telescope/instrument that is not specifically designed to do so. Permanent and irreversible eye damage can happen when looking at the sun without proper equipment.

Starting Out

SUNoculars® allow you to safely study eclipses, planetary transits, and sunspot activity/magnetic storms. This instrument reduces the light of the sun to a comfortable range and all ultra-violet and infrared components are completely and safely blocked out.

Please make sure to carefully read and follow all safety and use instructions found within this kit before using these SUNoculars®.

Never use SUNoculars® if they have visible scratches or damage.

When using this instrument, always place the SUNoculars® to your eyes first **BEFORE** looking at the sun.
