



# Yard Pong Maker Kit

## Guide

Yard pong offers outdoor entertainment suitable for all ages. It's played similarly to beer pong but with large buckets on the ground instead of cups on a table. Whether it's a day or night, this glow in the dark set of yard pong will be fun for everyone!

### Starting Out

First, fill the buckets 2/3 of the way with water and then set up your playing field. Beginner players can start 15 feet apart and work up to 25 or 30 feet apart. Set up your buckets like the diagram below in a triangle shape.



Begin with a shoot-off or coin flip to determine the starting team. Players aim to sink balls into opponent's buckets, removing each bucket that is successfully hit. You win by clearing all opposing buckets. If the starting team wins, the other team gets one round of rebuttal. If the other team also eliminates all opposing buckets, both teams bringing back one bucket and continue the rounds. Each team can re-rack once per game, strategically rearranging their setup for a potential game-ending advantage.

For best glow results, leave the buckets and balls in the sun a few hours before playing.
