Starting Out

Origami is the Japanese art of creating sculptures with folded paper. It was practiced as early as the ninth century; by this time, the Japanese had perfected their system of making paper so supplies were abundant and no longer saved for just writing.

Origami is a wonderful creative outlet that also helps your child to practice fine motor skills as they learn to make the intricate folds. Additionally, it is great for sequential learning and helps introduce math concepts like geometry via the importance of shapes and angles in each sculpture's design.

Use the included guidebook to make beginning folds and shapes. Be sure to use a flat, hard surface! (You can purchase 10 additional sheets of plain origami paper from the Library for \$1).
