Open to two age groups: Kids (0-13), Adults (14+), who must live in Montgomery County or have a Washington-Centerville Public Library card.

Designs must not contain copyrighted material, offensive language, or inappropriate images.

Selection & Usage:

Three cards in each category will be chosen by Library staff for a community vote on Facebook, which will take place May 18-20. The winner in each category will be announced on May 22.

By submitting a design, you agree to abide by all rules of the contest, and you grant Washington-Centerville Public Library a perpetual and irrevocable right to reproduce, modify, or use the submission for any purposes without further permission from the participants and without compensation or attribution.
