**Library Wins Design Award**

One year after its grand re-opening, Woodbourne Library is being recognized by the American Institute of Architects for its design. Library officials and LWC Inc., the architects who designed the Woodbourne Library expansion and renovation, accepted the Honor Award, the highest accolade of its kind, for Newly Completed Buildings and/or Additions at a special luncheon on November 1<sup>st</sup>.

In September 2018, the Woodbourne Library reopened after a 19 month expansion and renovation project. Developed by LWC Inc., with feedback solicited from the local community, Woodbourne Library was expanded by approximately 10,000 sq. ft. and completely renovated. The resulting design of the building meet the needs of Library users now and in the future, while retaining the Mid-century Modern elements that make it an architectural treasure. "We are thrilled to receive this award and library patrons could not be happier with the redesigned Woodbourne Library," comments Liz Fultz, Library Director.
